A BYLAW TO AMEND ZONING BYLAW NO. 2/2007

The Council of the Resort Village of Pelican Pointe in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

The Bylaw No. 1/2000 respecting Zoning be amended as follows:

Part V - Section 6.- Residential Mobile Home District – d) Regulations by removing points 'v' and 'vi' and replacing them with

6. Regulations

Mayor/Administrator

- v. All mobile homes shall be placed on a safe and well constructed semipermanent foundation, or that of a more substantial construction
- vi. Mobile homes shall be skirted from the floor level to ground level; vii. Mobile homes with noticeably damaged or neglected exteriors may not be
- vii. Mobile homes with noticeably damaged or neglected exteriors may not be allowed to be placed in the Resort Village of Pelican Pointe at Council's discretion.
- viii. If a mobile home has noticeable traits of an unsafe dwelling, either interior or exterior, Council may not allow that home to be placed within the Resort Village of Pelican Pointe until such concerns are repaired to the satisfaction of Council.
