

THE RESORT VILLAGE OF PELICAN POINTE

BYLAW 2/2014

The Council for the Resort Village of Pelican Pointe in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. Title

1.1 This bylaw may be cited as Bonfires and Open Air Fires Bylaw, 2014

2. Purpose

2.1 The purpose of this Bylaw is to set out the minimum requirements and responsibilities for bonfires and open air fires within the Resort Village of Pelican Pointe.

3. Responsibilities:

3.1 The Resort Village of Pelican Pointe has limited fire protection. You are responsible for all damages or nuisance caused by fire or smoke to your own property as well as neighboring properties. Policies for the responsible bonfire and open air fires as follows:

- a. The fire must be contained in a non-combustible receptacle made of cement, rock, brick, clay, or sheet metal with a minimum 18 gauge thickness
- b. The fire pit must be located a safe distance from any combustible material
- c. Fires must be supervised by an adult at all times.
- d. Fires must be extinguished if smoke causes an unreasonable interference with the use and enjoyment of another person's property.
- e. Fire pits shall not be used in windy conditions.
- f. In the event the Fire Chief issues a Fire Ban, the use of fire pits will be prohibited.
- g. No open fires will be permitted on public property.
- h. An organized Beach function with council approval will be allowed

4. Coming into Force

4.1 This bylaw becomes effective on date of passing.
