BYLAW 1/2005

A BYLAW FOR NON-COMPLIANCE, 2005

The Council for the Resort Village of Pelican Pointe in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Title

This bylaw may be cited as The Non-Compliance Bylaw, 2005

Purpose

 The purpose of this Bylaw is to establish penalties and enforcement procedures for the contravention of an order issued pursuant to section 124, 126 or 130 or a notice issued pursuant to section 132 of *The Urban Municipality Act*

Application

3. The penalties and enforcement procedures in this bylaw shall apply with respect to an Order in Council issued by The Resort Village of Pelican Pointe

General Penalty

- 4. Every person who fails to comply with an order issued within the time specified:
 - a) shall be fined \$300.00 for a first offence, \$600.00 for a second offence, and increase by \$300.00 for subsequent offences, not to exceed \$2,000
 - b) For each day during which the non-compliance continues, a fine of \$50.00 for each day.

Coming Into Force

5. This Bylaw shall come into force on the day of its final passing.

Read a first time this 18th day of June, 2005

Read a second time this 18th day of June, 2005

Read a third time and passed this 18th day of June, 2005
