BYLAW NO 2/87


A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS.

The council of the Resort Village of Pelican Pointe, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:


1. Subject to sections 2 and 3 hereof, no person shall discharge a firearm, air gun or spring gun within this Resort Village.
2. This bylaw shall not apply wherein a Police Officer discharges his or her firearm in the course of his or her policing duty.
3. Any person found guilty of an infraction of any of the provisions of this bylaw shall be liable to the penalties provided in the general penalty bylaw of this Village.
