BYLAW NO 03-2021

A BYLAW TO ESTABLISH PROPERTY TAX INCENTIVES AND PENALTIES

The Council of the Resort Village of Pelican Pointe in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. Due Date:

Property and other taxes imposed by the Resort Village of Pelican Pointe are deemed to be imposed on the first day of January in each year and shall be due on December 31.

2. Penalty on Arrears of Taxes

- a. Taxes which remain unpaid after the 31st day of December on the year in which they are levied shall be subject to a penalty.
- b. The method of calculating the penalty shall be a simper rate of 15% per annum, added on January 1st applied to the total taxes that remain unpaid as at January 1 of the year in which the penalty is being applied.
- c. The penalty charges are to be added to and shall form part of the tax roll.

3. <u>Incentive Program – Prompt Payment</u>

- Discounts shall be allowed from the time the notice of the levy is sent until August 31 to encourage prompt payment of the current year's taxes on property
- b. Payment of current taxes from the time the notice of the levy is sent until the end of August shall be eligible for a discount of 15% of the amount paid.
- 4. Bylaw 10/88 adopted on 1st day of May 1988 is hereby repealed.

5. Coming into Force
