BYLAW NO 2018/02

A BYLAW TO RECOVER PROTECTIVE SERVICES COSTS

The Council of the **Resort Village of Pelican Pointe** in the Province of Saskatchewan enacts as follows:

1. In this bylaw:

- a) "Administrator" shall mean the administrator of the municipality;
- b) "Council" shall mean the council of the municipality; and
- c) "Municipality" shall mean the Resort Village of Pelican Pointe.


2. The cost of fire prevention, suppression and emergency response services shall be charged directly on the persons who receive the service in accordance with:

- Schedule "A" which is attached to and forming a part of this bylaw.

3. The Council may authorize the Administrator to add to the taxes of any property owned by the person referenced in Section 2 of this bylaw any amount which remains unpaid at the end of the calendar year

Schedule A

(Forming part of bylaw 2018/02 Protective Services Cost Recovery Bylaw)

The fire call-out fee to be paid for each incident attended to by the Siltou Fire Department shall be a sum of \$1,500.00 (one thousand, five hundred dollars).

The fire call-out fee to be paid for each mutual aid call out attended to by any other attending fire department(s) shall be their invoiced amount, recognizing each responding fire department will have their own specific call-out fee.
